

Journey to Doto (East Hokkaido)

★ Day 1 Okhotsk - Kusharō

Explore ancient pit dwellings at **Tokoro Ruins Forest**, then enjoy panoramic views of Japan's third-largest lake from **Lake Saroma Observatory**. In the afternoon, discover the unique marine life of the Sea of Okhotsk at the **Ryu-hyo Ice Museum**. Conclude your day at the **Abashiri Prison Museum**, where you can step inside historic wooden structures and experience their solemn history.

Accommodation: Prince Hotel Kusharō or similar

★ Day 2 Kusharō - Akan - Kushiro

Experience a day of nature and culture starting at **Mt. Io**, where you can observe volcanic fumaroles up close. Next, visit **Lake Mashu Observatory** to see its world-class, deep blue water clarity. In the afternoon, immerse yourself in indigenous traditions at the **Akan Ainu Village (Akan Kotan)**. Finish with a visit to the **Akan International Crane Center** to observe the majestic red-crowned cranes.

* The Art Gallery at Akan Kotan is closed on certain days. If closed, guests will have free time to explore the village.

Accommodation: Prince Hotel Kushiro or similar

★ Day 3 Kushiro - Obihiro

Start with a hike along the **Onnenai Wooden Path**, surrounded by seasonal wetlands and wild birds. Afterward, head to **Kushiro Fisherman's Wharf MOO** for fresh local seafood and shopping. Continue to **Ryugetu Sweetpia Garden**, a famous Hokkaido sweets factory outlet, and end your journey with a stroll through the peaceful grounds of **Obihiro Shrine**, a known haven for the adorable "*Shimaenaga*" (long-tailed tit) bird.

Accommodation: Hotel Nikko Northland Obihiro or similar
