Operating hours and offers at some stores/restaurants are limited.

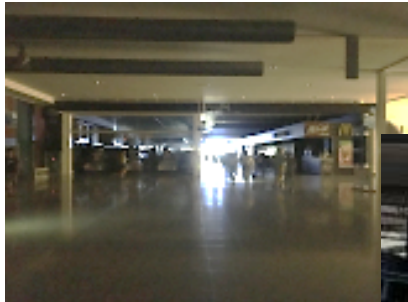
Access
