Nene no Michi lane is one of the reasons to make the trip to Kyoto. Nene no Michi is unique in that it adheres to Kyoto building codes: there are no garish signs and telephone wires have been buried. In Kyoto, that makes it both beautiful and very unusual. This lane has so many photo spots especially if you are wearing Yukata.



18:30 Japanese tea ceremony at Kogetsuan tea house

19:00 Special nighttime entrance at Kodaiji Temple

Built in 1606, Toyotomi Hideyoshi (Kanpaku from 1583 to 1598) and his wife Kita-no-Mandokoro are both enshrined in this highly decorated and beautifully landscaped temple
