

How to get to Tsukuba Center

Get off at Tsukuba Station and go to Exit A3.

By JR Joban Line

Get off at Tsuchiura Station and go to West Exit. Take the bus bound for "Tsukuba Center" or "Tsukuba Daigaku" (approx. 25 min).

From Tokyo Station: Go through Yaesu South Exit to bus stop No.2. Take the bus bound for "Tsukuba Center" or "Tsukuba Daigaku" (approx. 65 min). From Mito Station: Go to South Exit and take the bus bound for "Tsukuba Center" (approx. 60 min).

Get off at Sakura-Tsuchiura Interchange and head for Tsukuba direction. Turn right at Sasagi intersection (approx. 15 min).
