## **JIDAI MATSURI Festival (late October)**

The Jidai Matsuri Festival is one of the three most renowned festivals of Kyoto. It consists of a large procession that travels from the Imperial Palace to Heian Jingu Shrine. Jidai Matsuri is Japanese for "Festival of Ages", and the participants of the procession are dressed in accurate costumes from almost every period of Japanese history, as well as famous historical figures. ## **KOTOBUKI-KAI (November)**

Kamishichiken is the oldest of Kyoto's five licensed geisha districts. Every Autumn and for a limited time only (6 days), Kotobuki-kai showcases Maiko & Geiko's performances of dance and traditional Japanese music.
